

PRE-ORDERING REGULATIONS OF HUNGARIAN MINT LTD.
(Valid from: 7 December 2022)

1. Pre-ordering is possible for the commemorative coins offered in the issuing programme each year.
2. Submission of a pre-order request is not considered to be an order, and the acceptance and registration of such a request does not constitute a completed order confirmation.
3. Pre-ordering becomes possible after official publication of the issuing programme on the MNB's website.
4. Pre-order requests may only be submitted electronically on our Website (www.penzvero.hu) using the pre-order page within 21 calendar days of the pre-ordering announcement. Registration is closed at the end of the pre-order period and subsequent requests are not accepted.
5. Pre-order requests received electronically are automatically registered by the system in the order of receipt.
6. Pre-ordering must be confirmed separately for each coin type for each issue. Clients who pre-order will receive a notification sent to the e-mail address provided during the pre-ordering process on the possibility to confirm their order **14 days prior to the issue date**.
7. In addition to confirming the pre-order, it is also possible to reduce the number of pre-ordered coins using the Pre-order menu point. We allow **7 calendar days for the confirmation of pre-orders**. In the event that confirmation does not occur, the item in question is deleted from the pre-order system and the coins thus released are made available for online sale in the Webshop on the day of issue.
8. Pre-ordering clients receive an automatic notification on the receipt of the pre-order request and then later a confirmation e-mail on successful confirmation of pre-ordering for each item.
9. Natural persons (registered users) may order a maximum of 3 pcs of each coin type. **One online pre-order request may be submitted per registered user.** Customers who pre-order with receipt in person may authorise a third person to receive the pre-ordered items, but in all such cases a written authorisation, in the form of a private document providing full evidence is required. The authorisation must contain the information necessary for identifying the pre-ordering party and the pre-ordered items (e.g. name, address, name of product). In certain cases, the Hungarian Mint Ltd. (Company) reserves the right to stipulate receipt conditions differing from the above. **A natural person may undertake receipt in person for a maximum of 2 people based on such authorisation.**
10. Group pre-ordering is not possible; natural persons may only submit pre-order requests on their own behalf.
11. We reserve the right to alter the prices and issue dates announced in the pre-order publication and to limit the quantities available for pre-ordering. The prices stated in the publication do not include delivery costs. In the case of oversubscription, the limitation of quantities occurs

based on order of receipt and the rules of allocation. Clients who pre-ordered can find information on the limitation of available quantities in the issuing announcement.

12. The issuer MNB reserves the right to modify the maximum announced quantity that can be minted and the other conditions of the issuing programme.
13. Prior to issue of the items in question, pre-order requests can be withdrawn in writing by sending an e-mail to coins@hu.inter.net.
14. We ensure the opportunity to take personal receipt of the pre-ordered items for a period of one month from the date of issue as published for the specific item in the Hungarian Official Journal.
15. Information on specific issues can be found in the Hungarian Official Journal, our electronic newsletter, the pre-ordering announcement and, from the date of issue, on our Website.
16. Following expiration of the pre-order period, additional pre-order requests or reservations may not be submitted.
17. A maximum of 50% of the total quantity announced for minting is available for pre-ordering. The remaining 40% is intended for export and retail purposes, including the Hungarian Numismatic Collectors Society (MÉE). Another 10% is available for purchase exclusively online from the day of issue.
18. In justified cases, deviation from the distribution ratio is possible, with approval by the chief executive officer.
19. A maximum of 7,000 pcs can be pre-ordered from coins with an issuance volume of 20,000 pcs.
20. Items that are not allocated in the course of pre-ordering are available for purchase from the issue date on the Mint's Website and in the coin shop. Items that were pre-ordered but not picked up are sold after expiration of the one-month receipt period.
21. Pre-order requests must be renewed annually for new issues.
